Start Over in God's Blessing

Anytime we enter into a new year, it's the start of new beginnings. If you didn't do what you know God wanted you to do in 2019, don't beat yourself up. Repent to the Lord, put those failures in your past, and move on into God's victory. After the flood, there was only one family left on the earth. The flood wiped out the whole human race except for Noah and his family. God was ready to start all over again. I'm going to give you some Scripture verses for you to meditate on this week.

Genesis 8:13-16,18-22 NLT Noah was now 601 years old. On the first day of the new year, ten and a half months after the flood began, the floodwaters had almost dried up from the earth. Noah lifted back the covering of the boat and saw that the surface of the ground was drying. [14] Two more months went by, and at last the earth was dry! [15] Then God said to Noah, [16] "Leave the boat, all of you-you and your wife, and your sons and their wives. [17] Release all the animals-the birds, the livestock, and the small animals that scurry along the ground-so they can be fruitful and multiply throughout the earth."

[18] So Noah, his wife, and his sons and their wives left the boat. [19] And all of the large and small animals and birds came out of the boat, pair by pair. [20] Then Noah built an altar to the LORD, and there he sacrificed as burnt offerings the animals and birds that had been approved for that purpose. [21] And the LORD was pleased with the aroma of the sacrifice and said to himself, "I will never again curse the ground because of the human race, even though everything they think or imagine is bent toward evil from childhood. I will never again destroy all living things. [22] As long as the earth remains, there will be planting and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night."

When they got off the boat, the first thing Noah did was to build an altar and then make sacrifices to the Lord. In verse 21, we see that God was pleased with the sacrifice and lifted the curse off the ground. For the first time since Adam sinned, the earth would be able to bring forth fruit unhindered by Adam's curse. When mankind started planting crops, the earth brought forth the abundance.

When Jesus gave Himself as the Sacrifice, the curse that had been on mankind's heart was lifted off all those that believe in Jesus. Now a New Testament believer can produce from their heart God's abundance without being hindered with the curse that was on mankind.

Galatians 3:13-14 KJV Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: [14] That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

When Noah got out of the boat, he had a new earth on which to live. When we get born again, we have a new spirit that can produce heaven on the earth.

In this new year, God is calling us to live out of our new life in Christ. 2019 is over! Now we are in 2020, and we will produce more for God than any other year in the history of this world.

Jesus could possibly come back in this year and catch us all away.
