

God Saved Us From His Own Judgement

Ezekiel 22:30-31 KJV And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before Me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none. [31] Therefore have I poured out Mine indignation upon them; I have consumed them with the fire of My wrath: their own way have I recompensed upon their heads, saith the Lord God.

God was looking for a man in the Old Testament that would stop His own judgement, and He found none. But then, we fast forward to the New Testament where He found that Man. His name was Jesus. 2 Peter 3:9 KJV The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

In these verses, we see what God's desire is. He does not want to condemn or to judge any man for their sins. God has done His part, now man has to do their part. Man's part is to repent, turn to God and let Him save them.
