## God Wants All Saved and Healed!!!

So many times when God's children get sick, they really have doubts about God's will to heal them. They know God doesn't want them to go to hell, but they doubt about Him wanting to heal them. The reason for this is because the devil is using the sickness symptoms to try convince them that they can't depend on God to heal them. In this Newsletter I want to show you what my Father God has showed me about His will and desires for His Church in healing.

Matthew 8:1-3 KJV When He was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed Him. [2] And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped Him, saying, Lord, if Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean. [3] And Jesus put forth His hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Notice that the leper didn't know the will of Jesus concerning his healing, so he said 'if You will You can heal me, then Jesus said I will'. Jesus is saying the same thing to all of us as His children. I've been studying Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Nowhere in Jesus' earthly ministry did Jesus ever say no to healing someone that asked Him. I know Jesus is the same today as He was back then. Let us look at some more cases.

Matthew 8:5-8 KJV And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a centurion, beseeching Him, [6] And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. [7] And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him. [8] The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that Thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

Notice that Jesus didn't say I won't heal him; He said 'I will come and heal him'.

Matthew 8:16-17 KJV When the even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits with His Word, and healed all that were sick: [17] That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Notice Jesus never turned any of these people down. They wanted to be healed, and He healed every one of them. By doing so, He also was fulfilling Scriptures.

It's never God's will for His people to not receive their healing. We must receive His will for us, our loved ones and His church. The power of God goes into effect when we exercise our faith in God's word and His will. Don't let the devil try to tell you that God doesn't want to heal. He is a liar! God has always wanted to save every person that will allow Him to save them and heal them as well.

We are living in a world with much sickness. At times, we will have attacks on our bodies. We must learn how much God loves us and how much He wants to heal us. The ministry of Jesus on the earth 2000 years ago was filled with the powerful healing of the masses. He wants to still do the same thing today as then.

Fill your heart with His will. Know beyond a shadow of a doubt that Jesus will heal all.
