

## God's Kingdom Blessings

**Colossians 1:12-13 KJV** Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: [13] Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the Kingdom of His dear Son:

When we enter into the Kingdom God, we have legal rights to receive all of the benefits of the Kingdom. It's like if you were a member of the Kiwanis club, you could enjoy all that the club offers its members.

Another example would be if you rented a room at a hotel, and the hotel had a swimming pool. You could swim in the pool, because you rented the room. The swimming pool is there for you to take advantage of, but if you don't want to swim, you won't get the benefit of the pool. But anytime you want, it's there for you to take advantage of.

In God's Kingdom, there are tremendous blessings of which believers can partake. But believers must know what these blessings are and then exercise faith to receive them.

**2 Corinthians 1:20 KJV** For all the promises of God in Him are yea, and in Him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

We must take these promises by faith just like we take a paycheck from our work. We've worked for the money, so we take it and are blessed. Jesus worked for our benefits in the Kingdom, so take them and be blessed!

Our Confession Booklet on our web site, [lawtonchristiancenter.org](http://lawtonchristiancenter.org), is full of God's promises on about every subject of the Bible. I started receiving these promises over 30 years ago, and I cannot tell you how many times God has provided His Kingdom benefits for myself, my friends and my family. Over the years, I have spent thousands of hours confessing the Confession Booklet. God has come through over and over again. We are in the most powerful Kingdom that has ever existed.

Before Jesus came to Earth, the Kingdom of God was in Heaven. Now it's in us, because Jesus is the King of the Kingdom; and He lives in us. Before Jesus came, mankind lived with very few benefits from God's Kingdom; because His Kingdom had not yet been established on the earth. In the next few Scripture verses, you'll see God establishing His Kingdom through Jesus on the earth. Let's look at them.

**John 3:3 KJV** Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God.

**Matthew 3:1-2 KJV** In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,

[2] And saying, Repent ye: for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.

**Matthew 4:17 KJV** From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.

Notice in these verses that when they were each starting their ministries, John and Jesus preached the Kingdom of God. Jesus would tell His disciples, 'go heal the sick and say the Kingdom of God has come near you'. Jesus would teach parables and

say things like, the Kingdom of God is likened unto a sower...the Kingdom of God is likened unto leaven...the Kingdom of God is likened unto treasure hid in a field. Jesus taught on the Kingdom of God more than any other subject. He knew that He was receiving people into His Kingdom, and they needed to know what it was all about.

**Matthew 4:23 KJV** And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the Kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

**Matthew [11:11-12](#) KJV** Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than he.

[12] And from the days of John the Baptist until now the Kingdom of Heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

**Matthew 12:28 KJV** But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the Kingdom of God is come unto you.

Now as we close this Newsletter, I want to give you a homework assignment. I want you to study **Matthew 6:25-24** till you no longer worry, because you will know that you're in God's Kingdom. You will see that He will take care of you as you seek the Kingdom, which is God's way of doing and being right.
