[2] Abram: (Eternal Lord,) what could You possibly give to me that would make that much of a difference in my life? After all, I am still childless, and Eliezer of Damascus stands to inherit all I own. [3] Since You have not given me the gift of children, my only heir will be one of the servants born in my household. [4] Immediately the word of the Eternal One came to him. (Eternal One:) No, Abram, this man will not be your heir. No one but your very own child will be an heir for you. [5] God took him outside to show him something. (Eternal One:) Look up at the stars, and try to count them all if you can. There are too many to count! Your descendants will be as many as the stars. [6] Abram believed God and trusted in His promises, so God counted it to his favor as righteousness.

The way God can move and bless in our lives is by us believing what He believes for us. God believes what He sees, He sees our future and He believes it. He sees it like we see our now. As we see what He sees, it will come to pass in our lives. We must visualize the Bible; not just read it. It is a book of Vision, it speaks of a wonderful future for us.

Luke 18:27 Voice Jesus: Remember, what is humanly impossible is possible with God.

We are entering into a New Year. I believe this is the year that we will see spiritually; not just naturally. Seeing naturally is boring; seeing spiritually is exciting. In the natural good sight is 2020 vision. This is the year of 2020 read God's Spiritual Book called the Bible.
