

Our Heavenly Father

Today I would like to share with you on the subject of our Heavenly Father. In the New Testament, we constantly see the term 'father' referencing the Father God. So in this newsletter, I'm going to show you that Jesus did all He did through His Father's power; and we, as born-again Christians, now have the same Father. But we must have a close, intimate relationship with Him, just like Jesus did, if we expect to live a powerful Christian life on the earth.

My Heavenly Father will always be my dad. I will never be without supply, I will never be without love. Billions of years will come and go, and my eternal Father will be with me. So I never have to be in fear or worried about anything!

John 14:10-14 KJV Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of Myself: but the Father that dwelleth in Me, He doeth the works. [11] Believe Me that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me: or else believe Me for the very works' sake. [12] Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. [13] And whatsoever ye shall ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. [14] If ye shall ask any thing in My name, I will do it.

Notice Jesus said that His Father was in Him doing the works. That means that every miracle Jesus did came forth from the Father that lived in Jesus. What about now? Where is the Father now on the earth? We know Jesus went to Heaven. Did He take the Father with Him, or is He still on the earth?

Galatians 4:4-7 KJV But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law, [5] To redeem them that were under the law, that we might

receive the adoption of sons. [6] And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. [7] Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

We have heard that Jesus was born on the earth so He could die for our sins, which is the truth. But He also came to show us the Father God's desire for mankind.

John 1:18 AMP No man has ever seen God at any time; the only unique Son, or the only begotten God, Who is in the bosom in the intimate presence of the Father, He has declared Him, He has revealed Him and brought Him out where He can be seen; He has interpreted Him and He has made Him known.

Jesus becoming a man and living His Father's life on the earth gives us a picture of God the Father's desire. Even when we just read a couple of verses in the Bible, it can change our lives forever!

John 3:16-17 KJV For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. [17] For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

This is Father God's will for mankind, that they might be saved.

I want to encourage you this week to study the relationship that Jesus had with His Father, and remember you have the same Father.
