Genesis 3:1-4 KJV Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? [2] And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: [3] But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. [4] And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

Genesis 3:1-4 AMPC Now the serpent was more subtle and crafty than any living creature of the field which the Lord God had made. And he [Satan] said to the woman, Can it really be that God has said, You shall not eat from every tree of the garden? [2] And the woman said to the serpent, We may eat the fruit from the trees of the garden, [3] Except the fruit from the tree which is in the middle of the garden. God has said, You shall not eat of it, neither shall you touch it, lest you die. [4] But the serpent said to the woman, You shall not surely die,

I believe we can see in these Scriptures that Eve got into trouble by entertaining the devil's question. She should have said 'God said we are not suppose to eat the fruit of this tree, so you're a liar! Shut up and get out of here!' She didn't do that, she let the devil keep on talking, and he eventually deceived her.

- 1 Timothy 2:13-14 AMPC For Adam was first formed, then Eve; [14] And it was not Adam who was deceived, but [the] woman who was deceived and deluded and fell into transgression.
- 2 Timothy 2:23 KJV But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

The devil is always speaking to us through people and in our own thoughts. He wants us to get into strife, and he does it with foolish and unlearned questions. How can I win someone to Jesus, if I'm in an argument with them? I must recognize the devil is behind the scenes getting them to say things to try to trick me. 1 Peter 5:8-9 KJV Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: [9] Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

When we get to Heaven, we won't have to fight; but while we are here on Earth, we must never quit fighting.
