He Is My Savior & My Keeper!!

Jesus came to save us from eternal damnation and from present-day curses. The curses that are on this earth do not have more power than my God!

Numbers 23:8, 19-20 KJV How shall I curse, whom God hath not cursed? or how shall I defy, whom the Lord hath not defied?

[19] God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent: hath He said, and shall He not do it? or hath He spoken, and shall He not make it good? [20] Behold, I have received commandment to bless: and He hath blessed; and I cannot reverse it.

Ephesians 1:3 KJV Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

If you study these verses, you will see the heart of God for mankind. Father God sent Jesus to become our curse so that we could be blessed. Any kind of curse that would try to come on us didn't come from our God! We must know God's desire or will for us. Jesus didn't take all that pain and punishment for us to have us go through it ourselves. When we receive the blessing of the Lord on our lives, it starts repelling the curse that is in this earth.

Springtime is on us; it's starting to warm up, and we can see the grass turning green. Something else is happening...weeds are growing. Weeds are the enemy to mankind. Farmers know that they must attack the weeds, if they are going to get a good crop.

I can remember when I was a boy going out to the cotton field to chop weeds. I had my hoe, and I killed a lot of weeds! The farmer knows that the weeds must go, if his crop is going to thrive. The devil wants to curse us; God wants to bless us. We must chop the devil's curses out of our lives with God's Word. My spiritual hoe is speaking God's words!

Psalm 91:2-3 KJV I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust. [3] Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

Notice that we must 'say' to stop the devil's curses. Also to receive the blessings of the Lord into our lives, we must 'say'. As we speak God's Word, His blessings come on us. In the same way, the devil wants me speak his words so that curses will come on me.

When you want to go free, start saying what God has said about your freedom.

Psalm 118:17 KJV I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.

Genesis 12:2-3 KJV And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: [3] And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

I say that God's blessings are on me all the days of my life!

Genesis 50:15,19-20 KJV And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him. [19] And Joseph said unto them, Fear not: for am I in the place of God? [20] But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.

Joseph blessed his brothers, even though they had done him evil. God is that way to us. He never wants to hurt us, but He wants to bless us all the days of our lives.
