<u>Am I Standing on God's Truth or My Feelings and Emotions?</u>

Over the years, I've learned the devil can use my feelings and emotions to control me. As Christians, we are not fighting the devil but his deceptions. We are three-part beings; each of us is a spirit, we have a soul (mind, will, and emotions), and we live in a body. Our soul is attacked by the devil on a daily basis, and he's a master at deceiving us to use our souls to decide what is true or false. The only way to know the real truth is through the Word of God, with the help of the Holy Ghost. When an airplane pilot is flying by the instrument panel, they must not trust their natural perceptions, but believe what the instruments are saying to them. If they feel a different way than the readings on the instrument panel, they must trust the instruments above their feelings. Life and death are in the balance if they disregard the instrument readings. We are in a spiritual warfare; the Word of God is our instrument panel to guide us through these troubled times. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

Matthew 4:1-11 NIV Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. [2] After fasting forty days and forty nights, He was hungry. [3] The tempter came to Him and said, "If You are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." [4] Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' " [5] Then the devil took Him to the holy city and had Him stand on the highest point of the temple. [6] "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: " 'He will command His angels concerning you, and they will lift You up in their hands, so that You will not strike Your foot against a stone.' " [7] Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.' " [8] Again, the devil took Him to a very high mountain and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. [9] "All this I will give You," he said, "if You will bow down and worship me." [10] Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.' " [11] Then the devil left Him, and angels came and attended Him.

Jesus never told the devil how He was feeling, but stopped him every time by speaking the truth; not what He felt. I believe this is how we Christians can win; by always speaking the truth of God's Word; not our feelings.

Joshua 1:1,5-9 NIV After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide...[5] No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. [6] Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them. [7] "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law My servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. [8] Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. [9] Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

In these verses, God tells us how to not be deceived; meditation in God's Word. Always remember that the devil cannot win against God's Word. You can trust it even more than a pilot trusts their instruments. Also, remember your soul (mind, will, and emotions) has to be saved with the Word. When you are born again, your spirit is saved instantly; but your soul is saved progressively by putting yourself in HolyGhost University.
