Mankind was created with the right to choose, and this is great if we choose to listen to Him and do what He says. But it is truly sad that some people will not listen and receive Him as their personal savior. People that are not saved are running out of time. The return of the Lord is really close. As you read this Newsletter, let your mind think about how close we are to Jesus' return; and do your best to help people receive their eternal salvation.

2 Timothy 3:1-7 TPT But you need to be aware that in the final days the culture of society will become extremely fierce and difficult for the people of God. [2] People will be self-centered lovers of themselves and obsessed with money. They will boast of great things as they strut around in their arrogant pride and mock all that is right. They will ignore their own families. They will be ungrateful and ungodly. [3] They will become addicted to hateful and malicious slander. Slaves to their desires, they will be ferocious, belligerent haters of what is good and right. [4] With brutal treachery, they will act without restraint, bigoted and wrapped in clouds of their conceit. They will find their delight in the pleasures of this world more than the pleasures of the loving God. [5] They may pretend to have a respect for God, but in reality they want nothing to do with God's power. Stay away from people like these! [6] For they are the ones who worm their way into the hearts of vulnerable women, spending the night with those who are captured by their lusts and steeped in sin. [7] They are always learning but never discover the revelation-knowledge of truth.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 TPT Beloved brothers and sisters, we want you to be quite certain about the truth concerning those who have passed away, so that you won't be overwhelmed with grief like many others who have no hope. [14] For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, we also believe that God will bring with Jesus those who died while believing in Him. [15] This is the Word of the Lord: we who are alive in Him and remain on earth when the Lord appears will by no means have an advantage over those who have already died, for both will rise together. [16] For the Lord Himself will appear with the declaration of victory, the shout of an archangel, and the trumpet blast of God. He will descend from the heavenly realm and command those who are dead in Christ to rise first. [17] Then we who are alive will join them, transported together in clouds to have an encounter with the Lord in the air, and we will be forever joined with the Lord. [18] So encourage one another with these truths.

The Lord wants nobody to perish, so Jesus came that all could be saved! You might ask, "Why are people going to perish without Jesus?" In these verses we can see why. Because people reject God, they are actually committing spiritual suicide. They will go to a hell that was never made for them; it was made for the devil and his angels. We must do our best to pull unbelievers out of the fire.

Jude 1:21-23 KJV Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. [22] And of some have compassion, making a difference: [23] And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

Jesus said this about the devil and his angels in the last days.

Matthew 25:41 KJV Then shall He say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from Me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:
