Jesus' short life on Earth consisted of thirty years of learning His Father's will, then three and one half years of taking action to bring it to pass. Most of that time was healing the sick.

Hebrews 13:8 KJV Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

This Scripture declares that Jesus doesn't change. So if He spent the majority of His time healing the sick, then He still wants to do it today through us. We've all learned so much by watching people. I'm convinced that we can do the same thing by watching Jesus. The Bible was written so God could teach us. John 14:12 KJV Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father.

Healing the people that were sick was one of Jesus' most important jobs. There was hardly a day go by that Jesus wasn't using His Father's power to heal the people. I want to be like Him! I'm watching Him in the Bible, and I will do the same works that He did. Let's watch Him in action in these verses from the Bible.

Matthew 9:18-29 KJV While He spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped Him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay Thy hand upon her, and she shall live. [19] And Jesus arose, and followed him, and so did His disciples.[20] And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind Him, and touched the hem of His garment:[21] For she said within herself, If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole.[22] But Jesus turned Him about, and when He saw her, He said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.[23] And when Jesus came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise,[24] He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed Him to scorn.[25] But when the people were put forth, He went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.[26] And the fame hereof went abroad into all that land.[27] And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed Him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us.[28] And when He was come into the house, the blind men came to Him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto Him, Yea, Lord.[29] Then touched He their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

Mark [16:15-20](#) KJV And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. [17] And these signs shall follow them that believe;

In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; [18] They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. [19] So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, He was received up into Heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. [20] And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them , and confirming the word with signs following. Amen

Christians can be like Jesus by watching Him, stepping out and acting on His Words. I encourage you to be a disciple of Jesus; live out what He says on the earth. Also give yourself time to learn. It took Jesus a long time to teach His 12 disciples. Even though they blew it over and over, they became the leaders of the first Church.
