Taught by Father God

Every born again Christian is not just a forgiven sinner, they are God's own child. Jesus came to this earth to bring many sons into glory. God the Father sent Jesus to bring His new Family to Heaven. Let us look at some Scriptures that teach this.

Hebrews 2:9-11 KJV But we see Jesus, Who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that He by the grace of God should taste death for every man. [10] For it became Him, for Whom are all things, and by Whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the Captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. [11] For both He that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of One: for which cause He is not ashamed to call them brethren,

1 John 3:1-3 KJV Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew Him not. [2] Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.[3]And every man that hath this hope in Him purifieth himself, even as He is pure.

The purpose for God making man was for them to be His children. He wanted millions of children that would act like Him and talk like Him and He would be their very own Daddy! Yes, He is God; but, as His children, we should always think of Him as Father God.

Matthew 6:9-15 KJV After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in Heaven, Hallowed be Thy name. [10] Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in Earth, as it is in Heaven. [11] Give us this day our daily bread. [12] And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. [13] And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. [14] For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: [15] But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

We call this prayer "The Lord's Prayer", but I want you to see something very important; He didn't say, "the Lord which art in Heaven"; He said, "our Father which art in Heaven. I know He is our our Lord, but Jesus said to say, "our Father which art in Heaven. Jesus had a Father/Son relationship with the Creator of the universe! Jesus was teaching us to accept our new relationship with our Father God. A lot of our problems with not trusting God to provide for us is that we only see Him as God, and not as Father. Jesus knew His Father, which is our Father, would do what He said He would do.

Now, let's close this Newsletter with several Scriptures that reveal Father God.

John 5:23 KJV That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent Him.

6:37-40 All that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me; and him that cometh to Me I will in no wise cast out. [38] For I came down from Heaven, not to do Mine own will, but the will of Him that sent Me. [39] And this is the Father's will which hath sent Me, that of all which He hath given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. [40] And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

6:42-44 And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it then that He saith, I came down from Heaven? [43] Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves. [44] No man can come to Me, except the Father which hath sent Me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Ephesians 3:14-21 KJV For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, [15] Of Whom the whole family in Heaven and Earth is named, [16] That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man; [17] That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, [18] May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; [19] And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. [20] Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, [21] Unto Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

If we start calling God 'Father' like Jesus did, we will start seeing Him work in our lives like never before.
