How Can I Know That I'm Really Saved and Going to Heaven?

I've asked many people this question, "If you died, would you go to Heaven?" I've had many different answers, but so many non-Christians, and even some that are Christians, cannot answer that question. In this Newsletter we will show what the Bible says, so that people won't have to wonder anymore.

To know for sure if we are saved from hell and that Heaven will be our home, we must first make it clear to ourselves that the Bible has the only answer to this question. We must believe that God inspired men to write the Bible and that it truly is God talking to us. Let's look at some Bible Scriptures that speak about this subject.

John 1:1 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 3:34-36 KJV For He Whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto Him. [35] The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into His hand. [36] He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

Notice in these Scriptures that God said He (Jesus) is the Word of God. Then He said that when Jesus came, He was speaking the words of His Father. He said that if we believe on Jesus, we have everlasting life. So just in these few verses, we can start having confidence that we will be saved forever. Now let's look at some more Scriptures that bear this out.

John 3:15-18 KJV That whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. [16] For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. [17] For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. [18] He that believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

If a person believes in Jesus, the Bible tells them that they will be eternally saved. Now I do believe that we must understand what it means to believe in Jesus and why He is so important to our salvation.

1 John 4:10 NCV This is what real love is: It is not our love for God; it is God's love for us. He sent His Son to die in our place to take away our sins.

Jesus came to die in our place for our sins! We must realize that God is holy, and He cannot have true relationships with sinners. Jesus came to die in our place to satisfy

justice, because sin separates man from God. Therefore, God had His Son, Jesus, die for our sins so that He wouldn't have to punish US!  
I will finish this Newsletter with these last Scriptures.

Romans 3:22-25 NCV God makes people right with Himself through their faith in Jesus Christ. This is true for all who believe in Christ, because all people are the same: [23] Everyone has sinned and fallen short of God's glorious standard, [24] and all need to be made right with God by His grace, which is a free gift. They need to be made free from sin through Jesus Christ. [25] God sent Him to die in our place to take away our sins. We receive forgiveness through faith in the blood of Jesus' death. This showed that God always does what is right and fair, as in the past when He was patient and did not punish people for their sins.

If you have not yet believed that Jesus died for your sins and have not confessed with your mouth that He is your Lord, you need to do it today. If your family hasn't been saved, copy and paste this Newsletter; and send it to them so they can be saved from hell.
