

Prayer Is One of God's Spiritual Laws!

Natural law can be defined by the statement that "a particular phenomenon always occurs if certain conditions are present." The natural world we live in has laws that govern our universe. Our Father God, the Creator of this planet and the solar system we live in, created laws to keep things in order so we could survive in this universe. One of these laws we all know about is the law of gravity. Without this law in operation, everything and everyone not tied down would float off into outer space. How many people have died because they fell off their house; not respecting the law of gravity? Thousands have died because they broke the laws that govern the natural realm.

Now let us think about the realm of the spirit in which we also live. There are spiritual laws that God created for us to follow to succeed in our lives. Thousands of people suffer and/or die physically by not respecting spiritual laws. One of these laws is the Law of Prayer; which is communicating with God - speaking to Him, and Him speaking to us. Let's look at some aspects of this Law that will save, heal, and deliver us - if we act on them.

James 5:14-15 KJV Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: [15] And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

The aspect of anointing with oil and the prayer of faith, when acted on, will bring healing in the natural realm and salvation and forgiveness in the spiritual realm.

Mark 11:24 KJV Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

This is another aspect, or method, in the Law of Prayer; that of believing and receiving. If acted on, God will bring His power and supply into our natural and spiritual lives.

Psalms 91:14-16 KJV Because he hath set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known My name. [15] He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. [16] With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him My salvation.

Here is another aspect; that of setting our love upon God and calling out to Him. When we do, God promises deliverance, promotion, honor, long life and salvation.

In every one of these Scriptures we see different methods to the Law of Prayer. God is telling us that His power will be released on our behalf, when we pray.

So why don't people pray? It's because they don't really comprehend that God's power is released for them through their own prayers. Praying has almost stopped in most born-again Christians because of the lack of knowledge on this subject. One of the biggest reasons people don't pray is because they don't think it will do any good. They

think God decides if and when He will release His power for His children. They think His children have nothing to do with it. This is a lie the devil has told the Church. But the real truth is - read and really meditate on this - God has chosen to let His Church be in charge of releasing His power through the Law of Prayer He established! When the Church is praying, His power is flowing. When the Church stops praying, God's power stops manifesting. Let's look at Scripture that bears this out.

Matthew 21:22 KJV And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

7:7-8 KJV Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: [8] For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Jesus prayed this for His disciples in **John 17:9-11,15-16 KJV** I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which Thou hast given Me; for they are Thine. [10] And all Mine are Thine, and Thine are Mine; and I am glorified in them. [11] And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to Thee. Holy Father, keep through Thine own Name those whom Thou hast given Me, that they may be one, as We are. [15] I pray not that Thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that Thou shouldest keep them from the evil. [16] They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

Jesus knew about the Law of Prayer. If we want God to do something, we must pray; and He will release His power to bring it to pass.
