

We Are Everlasting Beings

Our Father has plans for us that are eternal, which means they will never stop. When we were born in the flesh, it was only for a short time. If we live to be 100 years old, that is very short compared to eternity. We must not let the devil trick us into just living for the short-lived life of the flesh. We are eternal beings. Look at these verses...

John 3:15-16 KJV That whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. [16] For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

3:36 KJV He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

5:24 KJV Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth My word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

6:47 KJV Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on Me hath everlasting life.

Romans 6:22-23 KJV But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. [23] For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

In these verses we see it over and over again that when we believe in Jesus, we receive everlasting life. God is trying to get us to wake up to the fact that our life is not a short life of the flesh; our life is eternal. We must think of ourselves as eternal, if we are really going to live a powerful life on the earth now. In the New Testament, we see everlasting life mentioned 26 times and eternal mentioned 45 times. Our Father God wants us to quit thinking of physical death as our end. When our flesh life is over, we are just beginning our forever life. You might ask, "Where will we live in our eternal home? What will it be like?" Study these verses, and you will really get excited!

Revelation 21:1-3,10-21 NCV Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth. The first heaven and the first earth had disappeared, and there was no sea anymore. [2] And I saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God. It was prepared like a bride dressed for her husband. [3] And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Now God's presence is with people, and He will live with them, and they will be His people. God Himself will be with them and will be their God. [10] And the angel carried me away by the Spirit to a very large and high mountain. He showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God. [11] It was shining with the glory of God and was bright like a very expensive jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal. [12] The city had a great high wall with twelve gates with twelve angels at the gates, and on each gate was written the name of one of the twelve tribes of Israel. [13] There were three gates on the east, three on the north, three on the south, and three on the west. [14] The walls of the city were built on twelve foundation stones, and on the stones were written the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. [15] The angel who talked with me had a measuring rod made of gold to measure the city, its gates, and its wall. [16] The city was built in a square, and its length was equal to its width. The angel measured the city with the rod. The city was 1,500 miles long, 1,500 miles wide, and 1,500 miles high. [17] The angel also measured the wall. It was 216 feet high, by human measurements, which the angel was using. [18] The wall was made of jasper, and the city was made of pure gold, as pure as glass. [19] The foundation stones of the city walls were decorated with every kind of jewel. The first foundation

was jasper, the second was sapphire, the third was chalcedony, the fourth was emerald, [20] the fifth was onyx, the sixth was carnelian, the seventh was chrysolite, the eighth was beryl, the ninth was topaz, the tenth was chrysoptase, the eleventh was jacinth, and the twelfth was amethyst. [21] The twelve gates were twelve pearls, each gate having been made from a single pearl. And the street of the city was made of pure gold as clear as glass.
