Having a Servant's Heart

Romans 6:17-18, KJV But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. [18] Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

Roman's 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

Jesus was a Son of His Father God, but He was not just His Son; He was His servant. He wants us to live the same way.

Matthew 20:25-28 KJV But Jesus called them unto Him, and said, Ye know that the princes of the Gentiles exercise dominion over them, and they that are great exercise authority upon them. [26] But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister; [27] And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant: [28] Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.

After we are born again and start growing up in the Lord, our Father God wants us to take on a servant's heart. We represent Him in the earth, and He wants us to bring His power to humanity to destroy the works of the devil.

Acts 10:38 KJV How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him.

We are in the earth now to destroy the works of the devil just like Jesus did while He was here. We are to use the Name of Jesus and stop the devil's manifestations on the earth.

When Jesus sent the disciples out, He gave them power to help humanity. Let's look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

Matthew 10:1 KJV And when He had called unto Him His twelve disciples, He gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Luke 10:1-9 KJV After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before His face into every city and place, whither He Himself would

come. [2] Therefore said He unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He would send forth labourers into His harvest. [3] Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves. [4] Carry neither purse, nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man by the way. [5] And into whatsoever house ye enter, first say, Peace be to this house. [6] And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again. [7] And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy of his hire. Go not from house to house. [8] And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you: [9] And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The Kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

Mark 16:16-20 KJV He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. [17] And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; [18] They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. [19] So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, He was received up into Heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. [20] And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the Word with signs following. Amen.

In these Scriptures, we see Jesus working in the believers to help people be freed from the power of satan. We, like them, are on a mission to be servants of our King to bring glory to His Name.

Galatians 1:10-11 KJV For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ. [11] But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

The Christian Church on the earth is where God lives. The more we serve people with God's love and power, the more the devil is stopped in the earth. Satan lost when Jesus died for our sins. He died so that we can bring His plan of redemption to mankind. The world is waiting for God's servants to bring God's power to set them free.
