Jesus Makes Us One With God

Satan separated man from God by getting them to sin. When sin is removed, however, man once again becomes one with his Creator. God's plan to remove the sin of man was a secret, and satan was completely fooled and caught off guard. He didn't understand that God was going to use Jesus' blood to remove man's sin. Let's look at some Scriptures that bring this out.

1 Corinthians 2:7-8 KJV But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: [8] Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Notice the word 'mystery'. This is a King James word for secret. Through Jesus' crucifixion, man's sins could be removed by the shed blood of Jesus. Here are some Scripture verses that show us that the blood of Jesus removes sin.

Romans 3:23-25 NLT For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. [24] Yet God, in His grace, freely makes us right in His sight. He did this through Christ Jesus when He freed us from the penalty for our sins. [25] For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed His life, shedding His blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when He held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past,

5:8-9 KJV But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

Ephesians 1:7 KJV In Whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace;

Hebrews 9:11-12 NCV But when Christ came as the high priest of the good things we now have, He entered the greater and more perfect tent. It is not made by humans and does not belong to this world.

[12] Christ entered the Most Holy Place only once-and for all time. He did not take with Him the blood of goats and calves. His sacrifice was His own blood, and by it He set us free from sin forever.

9:22 NCV The law says that almost everything must be made clean by blood, and sins cannot be forgiven without blood to show death.

Jesus died for our sins; His blood is the proof of His death, or you might say that His blood is the death certificate. Jesus' will and testament came in force when He died. Because He died, all of His heirs, which we are, can receive His inheritance.

Hebrews 9:14-17 KJV How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? [15] And for this cause He is the Mediator of the New Testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. [16] For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. [17] For a testament is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth.

Today everyone that receives Jesus as their Savior and Lord becomes heirs of Jesus by His death. We inherit all that He is and has. When a person writes a will on this earth, at his death the heirs can receive his inheritance if the death certificate is filed as proof of his death. The blood of Jesus has been filed in Heaven and placed on the mercy seat, and every Christian can now receive His inheritance by our faith and confession.

I want to encourage you today; don't live on your own wealth and abilities; receive His inheritance today.
