**Matthew 3:16-17 KJV** And Jesus, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him: [17] And lo a voice from Heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased.

**Acts 1:8 KJV** But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

I believe that when the Church neglects the Holy Ghost, they do it to their own peril. The mission of the Church is to preach the Gospel to the world, so that they can have a chance to be saved. The Church that preaches the Gospel without the Holy Ghost doesn't persuade very many people, and I know what I'm talking about. I tried to preach to people before I received the Holy Ghost, and I fell flat; but after I received Him, people started receiving what I was preaching. Also I started having signs follow me. People received healing and those that were tormented with demons began to be set free. The Holy Ghost made it happen. It's time the Church uses the power of the Holy Ghost to get the job done! The time is short; Jesus is coming soon!!

**Matthew 9:19-38 KJV** And Jesus arose, and followed him, and so did His disciples. [20] And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind Him, and touched the hem of His garment: [21] For she said within herself, If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole. [22] But Jesus turned Him about, and when He saw her, He said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. [23] And when Jesus came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise, [24] He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed Him to scorn. [25] But when the people were put forth, He went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose. [26] And the fame hereof went abroad into all that land. [27] And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed Him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us. [28] And when He was come into the house, the blind men came to Him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto Him, Yea, Lord. [29] Then touched He their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. [30] And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See that no man know it. [31] But they, when they were departed, spread abroad His fame in all that country. [32] As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a dumb man possessed with a devil. [33] And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. [34] But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils. [35] And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. [36] But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. [37] Then saith He unto His disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; [38] Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth labourers into His harvest.

**Matthew 10:1 KJV** And when He had called unto Him His twelve disciples, He gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all

manner of disease.

You can see in these Scriptures that the man, Jesus, needed help in His earthly ministry. He was overloaded with people needing help, so He gave the Holy Ghost power to His disciples. That's what God is doing now! If you want the Holy Ghost power, ask Him; God will give Him to you. There is a lot of work that we have to do; and fast!
