You Are Free, If You've Received Jesus

I want us to read some Scriptures today that show us what our Father God and Jesus, His Son, did to bring us out of sin and the devil's curse.

Galatians 3:13-14 TPT Yet, Christ paid the full price to set us free from the curse of the law. He absorbed it completely as He became a curse in our place. For it is written: "Everyone who is hung upon a tree is doubly cursed." [14] Jesus, our Messiah, was cursed in our place and in so doing, dissolved the curse from our lives, so that all the blessings of Abraham can be poured out upon even non-Jewish believers. And now God gives us the promise of the wonderful Holy Spirit who lives within us when we believe in Him.

Galatians 3:13-14 AMP

Christ purchased our freedom and redeemed us from the curse of the Law and its condemnation by becoming a curse for us-for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS [crucified] ON A TREE (cross)"- [14] in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might also come to the Gentiles, so that we would all receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit through faith.

When the church understands that they are redeemed, they will start living victorious Christian lives. What does it mean to be redeemed? The simplest way of describing it would be like a father having a son who got kidnapped. Even though the son is his, the father pays the ransom to get him back. The human race was stolen from Father God by the devil. God the Father paid the ransom for them with His Son Jesus in death.

Matthew 20:28 KJV Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.

1 Timothy 2:5-6 KJV For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; [6] Who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

Today we must not think that we caused ourselves to be kidnapped; the devil stole us away from God by Adam sinning in the garden.

Romans 5:17-19 KJV For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by One, Jesus Christ.) [18] Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. [19] For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of One shall many be made righteous.

When we receive Jesus, we receive freedom from the kidnapper who is the devil. He

has no power over us now, because the ransom has been paid; and we are free. The devil wants us to think that he still has power over us, but he is liar! Don't believe his lies.
